POWERING ON

Connecting to Power

Connect the included power adaptor to the Power Port located on the back of the unit and connect the wall plug to a working wall outlet



TIME SET UP

Default Time is set at 12:00PM

1. Press and HOLD the Time Button for 3 Seconds or until the clock Display begins blinking.



2. Press the 4 "+" or 5 "-" to adjust the time accordingly.
Press and HOLD down the buttons for faster scrolling.



(Top)

3. When finished, press the
3 Time Button to confirm and exit from Time Set-up Mode.



(Back)

Select Time Format (12/24 hr)

• To select your preferred time format, use the **17** "Time Format " switch located on the back of the device and flip the switch to 12hr or 24hr time format.



• When using the 12hr time format, the PM light will appear when you are entering PM time. The indicator will not appear during the 24hr format.

Daylight Saving Mode*

To adjust your clock's time -1/+1 hr VIA DST, use the B "Daylight Savings Time" switch located on the back of the device to adjust accordingly.

*Only applicable for areas that observe DST

ALARM SET UP



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2. *Press and HOLD the* **2** *Alarm button to enter set-up mode.*



(Front)

3. The LED display will blink if done correctly.



4. Press the **4** "+" or **5** "-" button to adjust the time.

For faster adjustment, press and HOLD the 4 "+" or 5 "-" button.



5. When the desired time is set, press the 2 Alarm button to complete the alarm set-up.

Setting up the Alarm Source

The alarm source selected will activate with the alarm(s).

You can change the alarm alert source by using the 12 switch controls located on the left side of the device.

- Panic Sound + Vibration
- Vibration
- Panic Sound



Setting up Shaker Alarm

To include the Wireless Shaker into your alarm routine, follow these steps:

1. Slide the power switch to "ON" by using the switch located on the shaker



2. The Wireless shaker alarm will activate ONLY on
12 Vibration or Panic Sound + Vibration Alarm settings.

- Panic Sound + Vibration
- Vibration
- Panic Sound (X)

3.Vibration Strength

Setting: Choose the strength level of vibration by using the 14 switch located on the right side of the device.

- Earthquake
- Normal

• Strong

• OFF (X)



Setting up Alarm Light

You can also add on the 16 Alarm Light to your scheduled alarm by using the switch controls located on the back of the device.

Alarm Light will work with all three alarm sources.

- Panic Sound + Vibration
- Vibration
- Panic Sound



Setting up Panic Volume

Adjust the volume of the Panic Alarm Sound by using the volume control located on the right side of the device.

Panic Alarm sound *will not* work with Vibration alarm source.

- Panic Sound + Vibration
- Vibration(X)
- Panic Sound



ENABLE/DISABLE ALARM

Please remember to activate/de-activate your alarm accordingly. If your turn off the alarm, you must enable it again for the alarm system to be activated.

To activate/de-activate your alarm, use the 11 switch controls located on the left side of the device

Switch setting

- Activate AL1 or AL2, AL1+AL2 for dual alarm
- Deactivate OFF



SNOOZE

- When the alarm is activated, the following options are available
- Snoozing your alarm: Press the 1 "SNOOZE" button located on the top of the device temporarily snooze your alarm. The snooze will silence your alarm in increments of 9 minutes.



After 60 minutes, the snooze function will no longer be available and the alarm will shut off completely until the next scheduled alarm. Stopping your alarm: To stop the alarm until the next scheduled time, press the 2 "Alarm" button located on the top of the device.



DISPLAY DIMMER

• The TimeShaker BOOM is equipped with a display dimmer. You can select the brightness level by pressing the 1 SNOOZE/DIMMER button during stand-by mode.



5 level brightness setting

(OFF > 100% > 75% > 50% > 25% > OFF)

• Display dimmer will NOT work while the alarm is active.

CHARGING WIRELESS SHAKER

- LED indicator on the wireless shaker. Refer to the light status indicators below:
 - Flashing red LED: Battery low
 Solid red LED: Charging
 LED off: Fully charged
- Charging the wireless shaker
 - 1. AC/DC Adapter (not included)







USB CHARGING PORT

To charge other devices such as a smartphone or tablet, connect the USB Charging cable to the
USB Charging port located on the right side of the device.

• The TimeShaker BOOM cannot access the content of the connected device.

Panic Volume Charge for Vibration Strength Shaker & P Earthquake

• The USB Charging port is compatible to most smartphones, tablets, portable speakers, wireless headphones, wearables, etc.

BACK-UP BATTERY WILL NOT OPERATE THE CLOCK

• The TimeShaker BOOM is equipped with a timekeeping system that can be powered with (2) AAA batteries (not included). The power failure protection circuit will not operate unless battery is installed.

• The back-up battery will save all previously programmed settings when normal household power is interrupted. The back-up battery will not operate the clock's normal functions.

• Normal operation will resume after the power is restored. You will not need to set-up the time/alarms if back-up battery is installed correctly.

INSTALLING BACK-UP BATTERY

The Back-up Battery is NOT a secondary source of power. The function acts as a memory saver for your settings in case of a disconnection of power. It is recommended to replace the battery at least once a year.

1. To remove the battery cover, 20 unscrew and slide the cover down

- **2.** Install two (2) AAA Batteries (not included)
- **3.** Place the battery cover back to its original position and fasten the screw



Q: How do I replace the backup batteries without losing your settings? (If old batteries are dead your setting will not be saved)

- A: Remove the power cord and shaker cord.
 - Locate the backup battery compartment on the bottom of the unit nd open it with a Philips screwdriver then remove the cover.
 - Plug the power cord in
 - Remove old batteries and insert 2 new "AAA" batteries.
 - Unplug the power cord.
 - Replace the cover. Do Not over tighten the screw.
 - Plug the power cord and shaker back in.
 - Check to confirm your setting are still saved.

Q: How do I re-sync the shaker in the case of a syncing issue?

- A: Ensure all alarm/alert settings are set to off during the SYNC process.
 - On the Device, Press and HOLD the 4"+" for 7 seconds to enter SYNC mode, If done correctly, the LED display will change into Sync mode
 - On the Wireless Shaker, while the device is in Sync mode, reset the Shaker by pressing the reset button with a small pin (not included), the Wireless Shaker will vibrate 3 times and the Light will flash blue to confirm that the device is synced
 - On the Device, press the 4 "+" button to exit Sync mode
